What Information Do We Collect?

ExperiGreen Lawn Care will not share, sell or lend your information to others. We are the sole party of the information collected on this site. Some pages on our website ask you for personally identifiable information such as: name, address, city, state, zip code, email address, and phone number. In general, you remain anonymous when you visit our website.

We do not collect personally identifiable information about you unless you knowingly and willingly provide your information to us.

We use broad, non-identifying aggregate information to identify movement trends throughout our website for the purpose of improving our content and service offerings. In short, this helps us tailor our site to create a better browsing experience.

So, What Do We Do With Your Information?

We use the information you provide us to contact you about the services available in your area. We may also use the information we collect to notify you about important changes to our website, new services, special offers we think you'll find valuable, and ask how we can better serve our customers

We Protect Your Children's Identity Too

ExperiGreen Lawn Care does not actively solicit to children, and we never knowingly ask children under the age of 13 to divulge personal information.
